Repetition is very important when learning to read. This week is all about reinforcing what we have learnt so far.

Begin with [WARM UP THE MOUTH GAMES](#) from last week

SYLLABLES

Can you remember how to clap the syllables in a word? Try and clap words from your favourite story.

ALLITERATION GAMES

HUBBLE BUBBLE

Collect a different set of objects that begin with the same sound eg bear, bat, box. Identify them and demonstrate the initial sound to your child eg b,b,b,b, box. Ask your child to repeat the sound.

Use a bowl or saucepan and a spoon. Say the rhyme below and add the objects as you stir.

Hubble, bubble, hubble, bubble,
What's in the pot?
Hubble, bubble, hubble, bubble,
What have got?
Bear and bat, bear and bat,
That's what we have got in the pot.

Repeat this several times using different sounds eg – m, p, d.
